

DETECTIVE DAVID TERRELL TAX # 931316, MANHATTAN
COURT SECTION**

1. Pursuant to a confidential internal investigation recorded under IAB Case #M-2026-0184, Charges and Specifications are preferred against Detective David Terrell, Tax #931316. This matter is being investigated by Sergeant Jeffrey Arceo Tax #945475, Group 1, Internal Affairs Bureau. Detective Terrell is not on probation. The details are as follows:

2. On January 23, 2026, at 1807 hours, former Member of the Service, Mr. Salvatore Grecco, spoke about an alleged sex crime that happened at 1 Police Plaza on his Twitter page under the handle @TheSalGreco. An OMNI form audit was conducted which showed Detective Terrell, who was assigned to the Manhattan Court Section, viewed the complaint report related to the alleged sex crime at 1434 hours. Subsequent reviews of phone records showed that Detective Terrell called Mr. Grecco twice on that same day, once before viewing the report at 1339 hours and once after viewing the report at 1711 hours.

3. On March 25, 2026, Detective Terrell was the subject of an official Department interview. After being confronted with the evidence, Detective Terrell stated that he was informed about the incident at 1P.P. by Mr. Grecco in their initial phone conversation at 1339 hours. Detective Terrell then ran the complainant report about the incident, to see if it was true. Detective Terrell admitted to confirming the validity of the incident to Mr. Grecco, disclosing confidential information that a crime report was alleged to have taken place at One Police Plaza in their subsequent phone call at 1711 hours.

4. During his testimony, Detective Terrell gave Misleading statements. Originally, he denied he viewed the complaint report for the sex assault in 1PP. He only admitted to querying the complaint after being reminded of the unusual nature of a sexual assault occurring at 1 Police Plaza. He later confirmed he did recall viewing the complaint report on January 23, 2026; to confirm rumors he had heard from Mr. Grecco. Detective Terrell stated he sometimes leaves his computer workstation unlocked and unattended and logged in.

5. Based upon the above investigation, Charges and Specifications are preferred against Detective Terrell for the following misconduct:

- Patrol Guide Procedure 219-14, Page 1, Para 2, "Department Computer Systems," in that on or about January 23, 2026, Detective David Terrell, assigned to the Manhattan Court Section, wrongfully accessed and made

queries in Department computer databases for unofficial non-Department related purposes.

- Administrative Guide Procedure 304-06, Page 1, Para 1, "Prohibited Conduct," and Administrative Guide Procedure 304-15, "Department Confidentiality Policy," in that on or about January 23, 2026, Detective David Terrell, assigned to the Manhattan Court Section, wrongfully disseminated confidential and/or non-public information obtained from Department computer databases.

- Administrative Guide Procedure 304-06, Page 1, Para 1, "Prohibited Conduct," and Administrative Guide Procedure 304-10, "False or Misleading Statements," in that on or about March 25, 2026, Detective David Terrell, assigned to the Manhattan Court Section, during an official Department interview conducted pursuant to AG 318-11, "Interrogation of Members of the Service," made false, inaccurate, or misleading statements to investigators when questioned about his communications with an individual, identity known to the Department, who is a social media personality.
