SPECIFICATIONS

1 Said Detective Shatorra Foster, while assigned to the Office of the First Deputy Commissioner, on or about and between December 2023 and September 2024, while both on-duty and off-duty, engaged in conduct prejudicial to the good order, efficiency, or discipline of the Department, in that said Detective intentionally, and for no legitimate purpose, engaged in a course of conduct directed at a specific person or persons, identity known to the Department, and knew, or reasonably should have known that said conduct was likely to cause reasonable fear of material harm to the physical health, safety, or property of such person or persons, or member of such person or persons' immediate family, or a third party with whom such person or persons were acquainted, or was likely to cause such person or persons to reasonably fear that her employment, business, or career was threatened, where such conduct consisted of appearing, telephoning, or initiating communication or contact at such person or persons' place of employment or business, and said Detective was informed previously and clearly to cease such conduct.

N.Y.S. Penal Law 120.45(1) and (2)

"Stalking in the fourth degree"

2 Said Detective Shatorra Foster, while assigned to the Office of the First Deputy Commissioner, on or about and between December 2023 and September 2024, while both on-duty and off-duty, engaged in conduct prejudicial to the good order, efficiency, or discipline of the Department, in that said Detective, with intent to harass another person or persons, identity known to the Department, communicated, anonymously or otherwise, by telephone, by computer or any other electronic means, or by mail, or by transmitting or delivering any other form of communication, a threat to cause physical harm to, or unlawful harm to the property of, such person or persons, or a member of such person's or persons' same family or household, and said Detective knew or reasonably should have known that such communication would cause such person or persons to reasonably fear harm to such person or persons' physical safety or property, or to the physical safety or property of a member of such person or person's same family or household.

"Aggravated harassment in the second degree"

3 Said Detective Shatorra Foster, while assigned to the Office of the First Deputy Commissioner, on or about multiple dates between July 5, 2024 and August 1, 2024, while both on-duty and off-duty, engaged in conduct prejudicial to the good order, efficiency, or discipline of the Department, in that said Detective, knowing that the information she reported, conveyed, or circulated to be false or baseless, initiated or circulated a false report or warning of an alleged occurrence or impending occurrence of a crime or emergency under

circumstances in which it was not unlikely that public alarm or inconvenience would result; or reported, by word or action, to an official or quasi-official agency or organization having the function of dealing with emergencies involving danger to life or property, an alleged occurrence or impending occurrence of an emergency which did not in fact occur or did not in fact exist; or gratuitously reported to a law enforcement officer or agency the alleged occurrence of an offense or incident which did not in fact occur; or an allegedly impending occurrence of an offense or incident which in fact was not about to occur; or false information relating to an actual offense or incident or to the alleged implication of some person therein.
