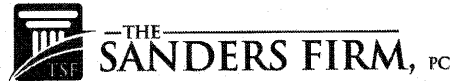

Good Afternoon:

Thank you for confirming receipt of my two emails and for providing IAB Log No. 2026-18936.

Please ensure that all materials submitted are preserved, reviewed, and associated with this log. Please also advise once the matter has been assigned to a specific IAB Unit/Group.

I am also supplementing the record to advise that my continuing review of the recently disclosed internal affairs materials, including the Prosecutorial Wall and SIU investigative files, further supports the allegations already raised.

The disclosed materials appear to show that the Department possessed information materially bearing on then-Lieutenant Trevlyn O. Headley's conduct, credibility, motive, Department-resource access, and potential retaliatory use of Department process. This includes, among other things, the documented November 15, 2023 CPR inquiry of Police Officer Shatorra J. Foster by Headley; the treatment of that substantiated computer misuse as a limited administrative matter; the use of inference-heavy digital attribution theories against Foster; the repeated 311 outcry-type reports concerning Headley's residence; the "jammed up," "scared and hurt," naked-picture, and "fix the open log" communications; and the continuation of the administrative case after criminal-side review did not proceed.

The significance of these materials is not limited to the pending disciplinary matter. They bear directly on whether Department resources, Department affiliations, internal personnel relationships, and investigative processes were used to monitor, control, retaliate against, or otherwise harm Foster, and whether the Department's subsequent investigative handling improperly minimized Headley-related conduct while treating Foster's conduct as charge-worthy.

Please treat this email as a supplemental notice under IAB Log No. 2026-18936. I request that the assigned Unit/Group review the Prosecutorial Wall and SIU files as part of this log, including the investigative handling of Headley's conduct, the treatment of Foster's allegations and outcry evidence, and the decision-making that resulted in Headley-related conduct being minimized while Foster was charged.

I represent Police Officer Shatorra J. Foster.

I previously submitted allegations to the Office of Equity and Inclusion and the Internal Affairs Bureau concerning serious misconduct, retaliation, failure to investigate, misuse of Department systems, and investigative contamination involving Trevlyn O. Headley and the Department's handling of respondent's pending disciplinary matter.

As of this writing, I have not received confirmation of receipt, assigned log numbers, or any response identifying the status of those submissions.

Please provide the assigned OEI and IAB log numbers, confirm that the allegations have been received and preserved, and identify the unit or investigator responsible for intake or review.

These allegations concern an active disciplinary prosecution and include issues bearing on respondent's statutory rights, victim-status protections, retaliation, selective enforcement, and the integrity of the underlying internal investigation. Respondent reserves all rights, including the right to seek appropriate relief in the pending disciplinary matter and in any related civil proceeding.
